



2014 North Carolina Poultry Jubilee Pageant

Applications are being accepted for the 2014 NC Poultry Jubilee Pageant to be held Saturday, September 13, 2014. The pageant is a very important and notable extension of the NC Poultry Jubilee. The pageant will be held at Wallace-Rose Hill High School Fine Arts Building in Teachey, NC.

Deadline to enter is August 16, 2014.

The NC Poultry Jubilee Pageant is a prestigious and glamorous event that inspires and promotes young ladies ages 3-19 from across the state of NC. These young ladies will serve as representatives of an industry, a people and a way of life that helps keep NC economically strong.

Age division is determined by your age the day of the pageant.

Wee Miss 3-4years old

Tiny Miss 5-6years old

Little Miss 7-9years old

Junior Miss 10-12years old

Young Miss 13-15years old

Miss Poultry Jubilee 16-19years old

Applications accepted on or before August 16, 2014, entry fee is \$75.00. After August 16, 2014 entry fee is \$100.00. Late applications will only be accepted through August 23, 2014. **Entry Fee is NON-REFUNDABLE.** Applications must be received completed, with entry fee, wallet sized photo and contestant information sheet included. Each Queen will receive a crown, trophy and sash. The Miss NC Poultry Jubilee Queen will receive a \$1000.00 college scholarship to be used for further education. All contestants will receive a trophy and gift.

NC Poultry Jubilee Pageant Rules and Regulations

1. Contestants must be single/never married, or given birth.
2. Contestants and/or parents are not allowed to approach the judges at any time during the pageant.
3. Judges decisions are final and indisputable.
4. Score sheets and Talent CD's will be available at the auditor's table immediately following the Crowning Ceremony. We will not be responsible for keeping or returning any items left behind.
5. No props are allowed for talent competitions.
6. Only contestants, 1 chaperone and 1 hair/makeup person are allowed in the dressing rooms. Only females will be allowed in the dressing rooms.
7. Contestants must be on time for scheduled competitions. We cannot delay competitions to wait for any contestant. It is the responsibility of the chaperone to insure that the contestant is on time for each event. The pageant staff will not be responsible for informing contestants of times for scheduled competitions during the pageant. A schedule of events will be listed in the program and a detailed schedule will be posted in the dressing room.
8. We would ask that everyone please wait before approaching the stage with your flowers, gifts, etc. until after pictures have been taken.
9. We reserve the right to disqualify any contestant or refuse entry to anyone in this or future pageants for poor sportsmanship or not honoring the duties of their title.
10. Contestant numbers, within each division, will be chosen based on the date that the completed application packet, including application/entry fee/wallet size photo/contestant information sheet, is received. A "first in, last out" system will be used.
11. There will be no double crowning.
12. Failure to meet application deadline of **August 23, 2014** will disqualify you from competing.
13. Age divisions are determined by the age of the contestant on **Pageant Day.**

Titleholder Requirements

1. ALL 2014 NC Poultry Jubilee Queens are REQUIRED to participate in the 2014 NC Poultry Jubilee to be held Saturday, October 3, 2014. This includes ALL Queens riding in the parade the morning of October 3rd and making a scheduled appearance during the festival (Times TBA).
2. ALL 2014 NC Poultry Jubilee Queens are REQUIRED to participate and ride in the Warsaw Veterans Parade to be held on Saturday, November 8, 2014.
3. ALL 2014 NC Poultry Jubilee Queens are REQUIRED to participate and ride in the Wallace Christmas Parade (December 2014, specific date TBA)
4. ALL 2014 NC Poultry Jubilee Queens are REQUIRED to participate in the 2015 NC Poultry Jubilee Pageant (September 2015, specific date TBA)
5. ALL 2014 NC Poultry Jubilee Queens are REQUIRED to wear their crown and sash at every appearance.

Contestant Requirements

1. ALL contestants for the 2014 NC Poultry Jubilee Pageant are required to submit an application, \$75 non refundable application fee, wallet size photo and contestant information sheet by August 16, 2014. Applications will be accepted up till August 23 but must include an entry fee of \$100.
2. ALL contestants for the 2014 NC Poultry Jubilee Pageant are required to attend all scheduled rehearsals:
Saturday, September 6 (location TBA)
Friday, September 12 (WRH Fine Arts Building)
3. ALL contestants for the 2014 NC Poultry Jubilee Pageant are required to attend the contestant meeting on August 16, 2014 at the Rose Hill Town Square.
4. ALL contestants for the 2014 NC Poultry Jubilee Pageant will receive a Pageant T-Shirt to be worn during the opening number and introduction of contestants portion of the pageant. These T-Shirts are to be worn with black bottoms (shorts, capris, or pants) and can be decorated to each contestant's choosing. The T-Shirt can NOT be cut in any way.
5. ALL contestants for the 2014 NC Poultry Jubilee Pageant are required to sell \$100.00 of ad sales for the program. All ad sales will go toward the NC Poultry Jubilee Pageant Scholarship Fund and the pageant itself. All ad sales are due by August 29, 2014. The contestant with the MOST ad sales will be given the title of AMBASSADOR NC POUTLRY JUBILEE QUEEN. She will receive a crown and sash. She will also be given the *OPTION* to participate in all events required by titleholders.

Areas of Competition:

The judges will be using a POINT system. There will be 4 judges. The maximum points you can receive, from each judge, during each phase of competition is 40 points. (And that is if each judge gives you a perfect 10.) The contestant with the MOST POINTS, at the end of the night, in her particular division, will be crowned the 2014 QUEEN!

INTERVIEW (Junior/Young/Miss) Your 4 minute interview will be held on Saturday, September 13th, before the pageant. (Time TBA). Judges will ask you questions about yourself, your school, current events, and items that are on your CONTESTANT INFORMATION SHEET. (*Make sure you keep a copy for yourself to review before Sept. 13th*) The interviews will be held in a conference room near the auditorium and you should wear a Sunday dress or suit that is age appropriate. Try not to wear a "BUSY" outfit because I want the judges to concentrate on your answers & not completely on your outfit.

CASUAL WEAR COMPETITION (All Divisions) During this phase of competition, the contestants are asked to wear a fun, bright outfit that will showcase their personality. This outfit should not be too dressy, but casual! Think, "snappy casual!". Shoes usually match the outfit or are neutral. The judges are not just judging the outfit; they are judging how well you carry yourself. Have fun, be creative, yet tasteful.

TALENT COMPETITION (Little/Junior/Young/Miss) Talent should NOT exceed 90 seconds. Points will be deducted if you exceed the time limit. You should select your talent, get the music, and perfect and polish your routine. A good quality CD to be used in the background is essential, unless you are playing the piano or performing a monologue. If you sing, make sure the song is appropriate and fits your vocal range. If you dance, be sure to use a variety of steps. It's always a good idea to get someone to critique your routine.

PARTY WEAR & ONSTAGE QUESTIONS (Wee/Tiny/Little) During this phase of competition, contestants are asked to wear dresses with a touch of bling or sparkle. Think "NEW YEAR'S EVE". No long dresses. No glitzy, pageant style dresses. White shoes and white socks are a requirement. Again, the judges are not just judging the outfit; they are judging how well you carry yourself. Have fun, be creative, yet tasteful. Contestants will come on stage, model their Party Wear, and then join Young Miss NC Poultry Jubilee 2013 for a short question/answer exchange. These questions will be simple and come directly from your CONTESTANT INFORMATION SHEET. ***We will practice the questions/answers on the eve of the pageant***

EVENING GOWN COMPETITION & ONSTAGE QUESTION (Junior/Young/Miss) Be sure that your evening gown is age appropriate. Dresses should reflect your age. They should fit nicely, the color should complement you and you should be able to walk in it comfortably. Heels are required. Practice walking in them before the pageant and bring them to each rehearsal.***On the eve of the pageant, you will select a question from the "bowl" as your ONSTAGE QUESTION. You will have one day to craft an answer for this phase of the competition. When asked the question, by our reigning Miss NC Poultry Jubilee 2013, you will respond to the judges with your answer.
