Purpose:

The North Carolina Poultry Jubilee is a non-profit organization coordinated by a committee of volunteers. The purpose of the festival is to promote the positive social and economic impact of the poultry industry on the citizens of North Carolina. To provide the opportunity for North Carolina non-profit, civic, church and educational organizations to raise funds through participation in the Jubilee. To educate the public about poultry and its importance to the state economy. To allow the public the opportunity to enjoy good 'ole fried chicken. To provide a scholarship program to help students obtain an education to better serve our communities.

Criteria:

1. Must be in your last year of high school.
2. Reside or attend school in one of the following counties in North Carolina: Duplin, Pender, Sampson, Wayne, Lenoir, Jones or Onslow.
3. Write and submit an essay on the provided topic.
4. Provide 2 references with one being from a teacher or counselor
5. Perform an interview with a poultry farmer.
6. You must exhibit good moral character. You may be asked for an interview by the NCPJ Committee.

Award:

The North Carolina Poultry Jubilee will award a \$2,500 scholarship in 2019. Any scholarship money awarded to the winner shall only be used for educational purposes. All monies will be paid directly to the college/university for tuition. No scholarship money will be given to individuals.

Selection Process:

Final selection of applicant to receive scholarship will be made by The North Carolina Poultry Jubilee Committee. The committee will give equal consideration to all applicants who fulfill the requirements. Decisions of the committee are final. All essays become the property of The North Carolina Poultry Jubilee.
